 Update: Ongoing - company keen to start opening factory and planning for behavioural change work around the middle of the week.
- 60/20 Arrange mop-up plan of postal kits/redirection to alternate testing site. List of 20 individuals without transport/unable to travel to testing centre forwarded to in BCUB

 Update: Number rose to 40 by midnight yesterday (19/06/20). It is looking at how testing will be supported.
- 73/20 Circulate final version of cases definition to the group.
- 76/20 Pick up off line the concern that contractors have continued to travel to Anglesey after 05/06/20 (Raised by Flintshire LA).
- 77/20 Look at results sent to TTP saying incomplete (Raised by Anglesey LA).
- 78/20 Separate Task and Finish group to be set up to discuss a protocol to deal with breaches of compliance -Group to include PHW as proper officers, EHOs from Anglesey and Gwynedd,
- 79/20 Key messages to be crafted by specialist behavioural teams in PHW leading this.
- 82/20 Anglesey EHO to prepare a request to co-operate letter to be sent to workforce who have not gone for testing. Group asked for this to be agreed by OCT before distribution.

4 Epidemiological Summary

- There is new confirmed case in the last 24 hours, 204 cases confirmed in total.
- There are 584 workers at the plant.
- We have results for 204 positive, 258 negative, and failed test.
- No positives on additional staff.
- 16 haven't been tested, isolating,
- Anglesey 30 tested are waiting results From WCP -11 are in progress.
- 34 have been swabbed and are waiting on a result but aren't sure if they are in progress.
- There are a number of individuals who haven't been tested as of yet.
- What are we going to do with them individuals and how we are going to peruse them to get them tested? Or accept that they won't engage?

- will give a better idea of numbers tomorrow 26/06/20
- Put on testing area in Bangor for 26 individuals no individuals turned up, equally there wear testing opportunities in Holyhead and only had a hand full despite having the military on hand.
- Find other ways of sampling but in order to do that need a clean list and a clear plan
- 59 staff linked with the 2 Sisters on Tarian from the 25of May.

5 Testing and Sampling

- There is cases confirmed in total.
- There are 584 workers at the plant.
- We have results for 204 positive, 258 negative, and failed test.

- From a testing capacity we have capacity to test, but we cannot we need a list if there is a plan to test/retesting.
- Issues with getting test results out

6 Review and control measures

- Meeting sight on 26/06/2020.
- Discussion between police and local authority's about what to do hasn't been concern expressed so far, people are happy to confirm their identity when discussing others.
- PHW to keep a log of all calls connected and can be shared with local authority and police so everyone is aware of what's going on.
- For Local authority's and police to do visits if necessary if people are not complying.
- Premise wasn't closed legally staff wear told to isolate as control that removed work force.
- Not looking to open till the 2nd, 4th or 5th of July.
- For the plant to confirm once the works have been completed and everything have been complied with, as reassurance we can move forward.
